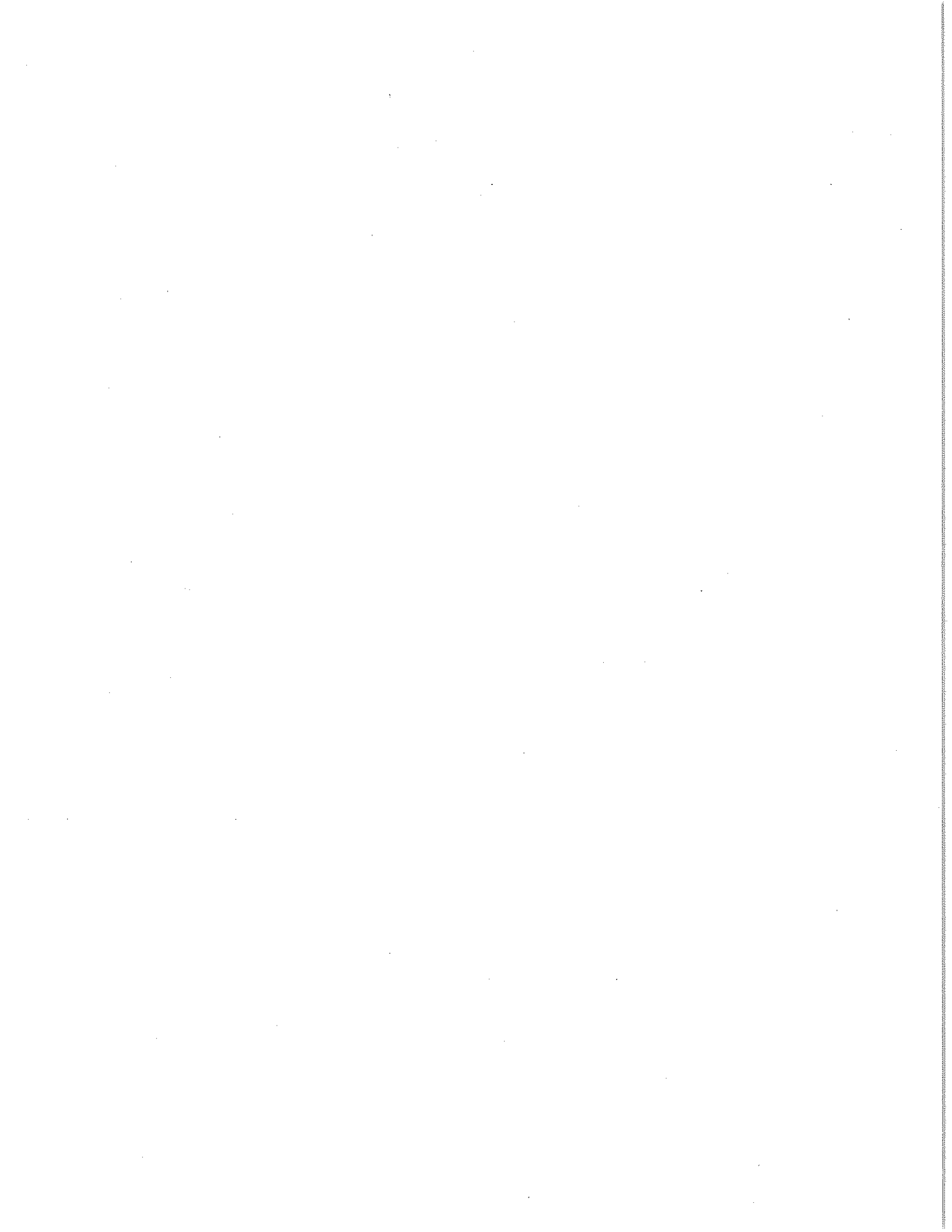

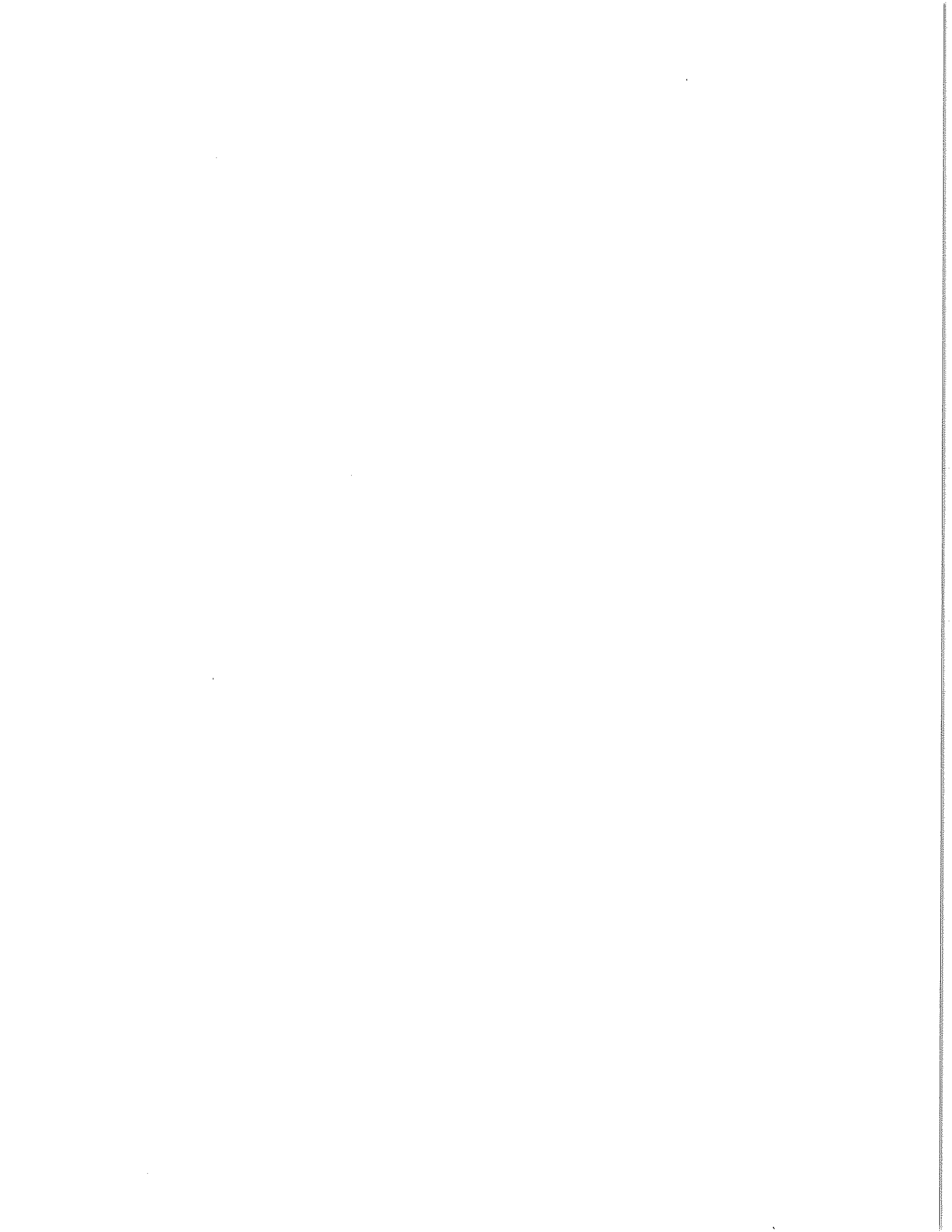

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that all persons will be given an opportunity to be heard on said proposed Local Law at the place and time aforesaid.

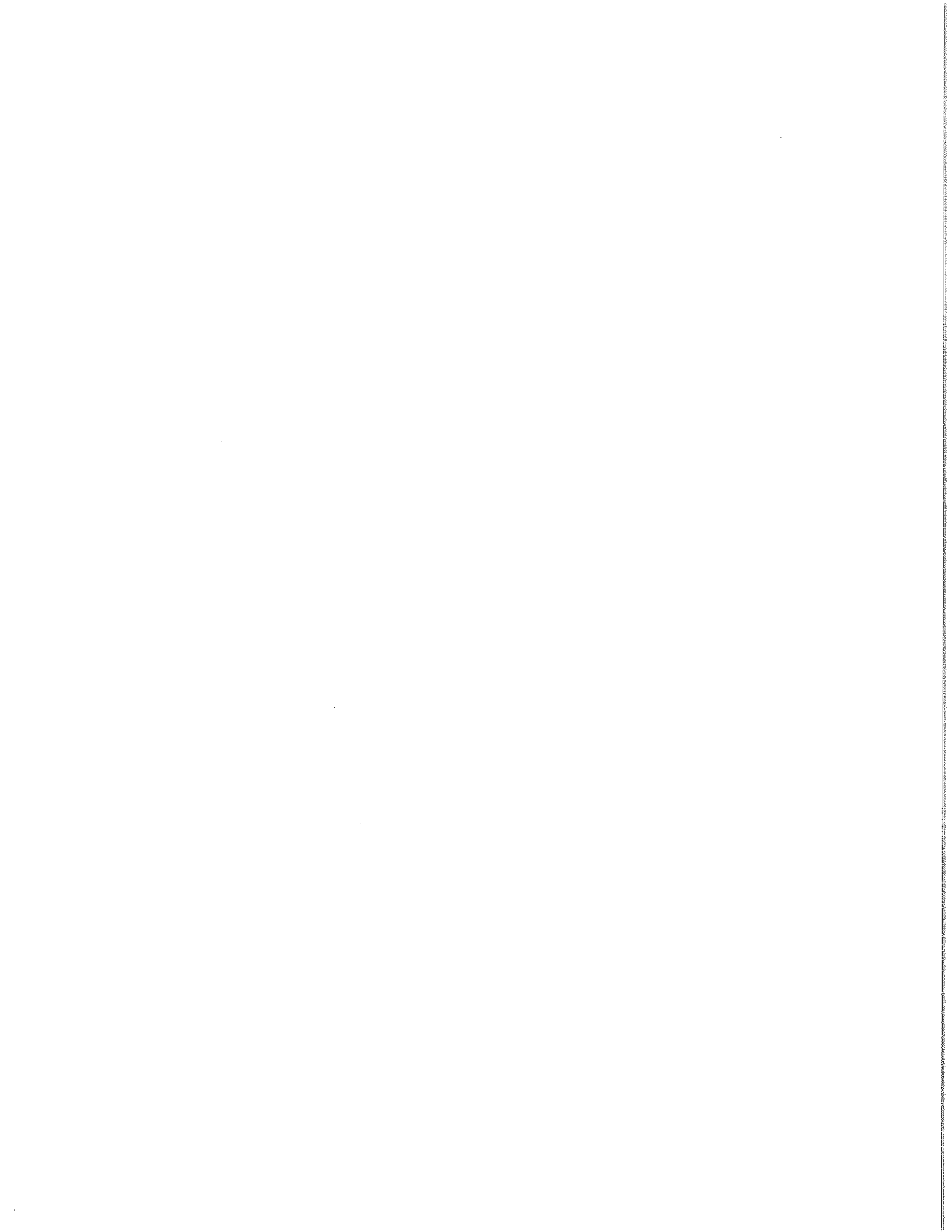

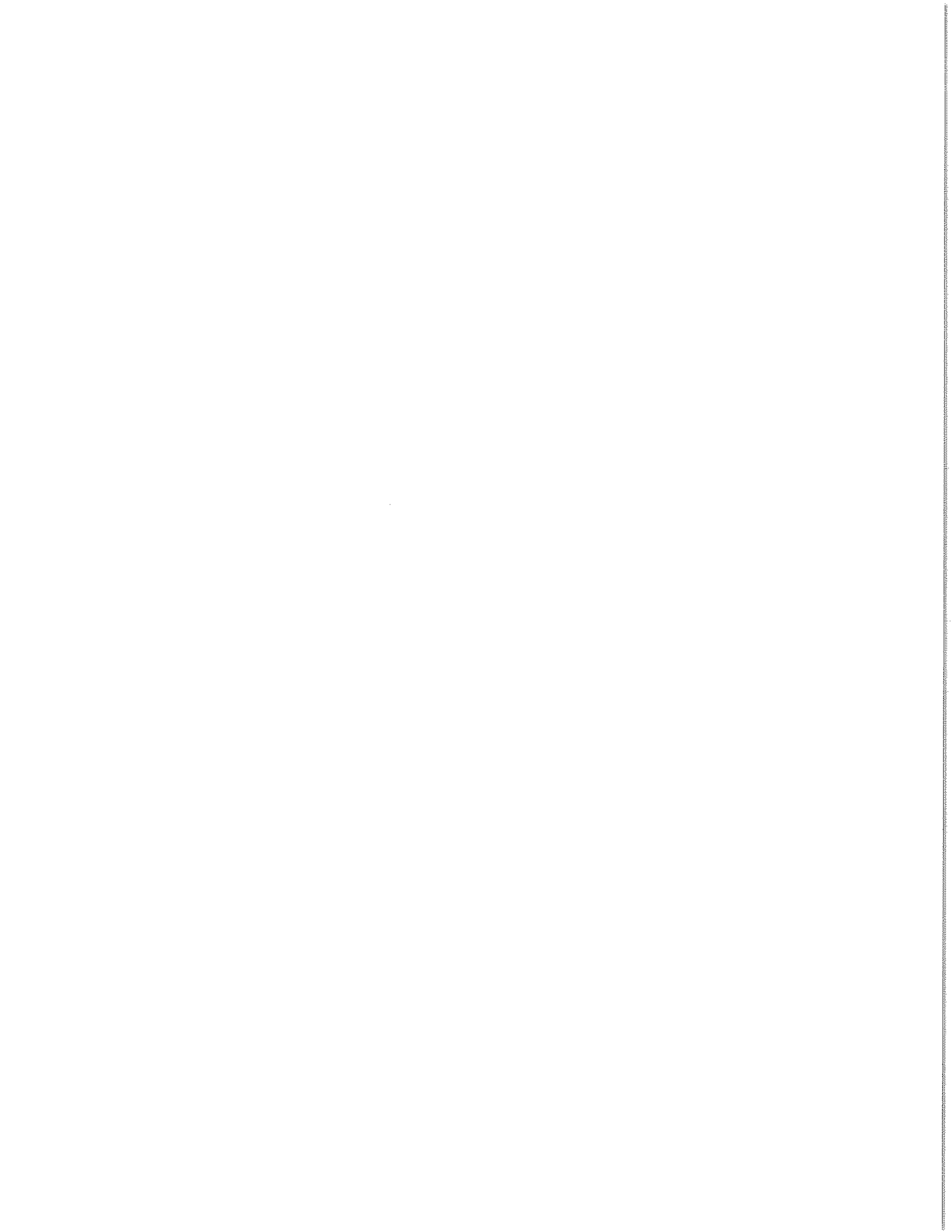

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR A FOUR-YEAR TERM
FOR THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF THE
TOWN SUPERVISOR FOR THE TOWN OF WHITESTOWN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE
TOWN OF WHITESTOWN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

The term of office of elective town supervisor of the Town of Whitestown shall be four (4) years. Such four (4) year term shall commence on the first day of January, 2020 and shall apply to the person elected to such office at the first biennial town election, to be held on November 5, 2019.

Section 2.

At the biennial town election to be held on November 5, 2019, and every four (4) years thereafter, the town supervisor shall be elected for a term of four (4) years.

Section 3.

This Local Law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Whitestown, section 24 of the Town Law of New York State, with respect to the term of office of the elective town supervisor, and shall be applicable and otherwise adopted pursuant to Sections 10 and 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Section 4.

This Local Law shall be submitted for approval to the electors of the Town of Whitestown at the next general town election to be held on November 5, 2019.

Section 5.

Any other local law, ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 6.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

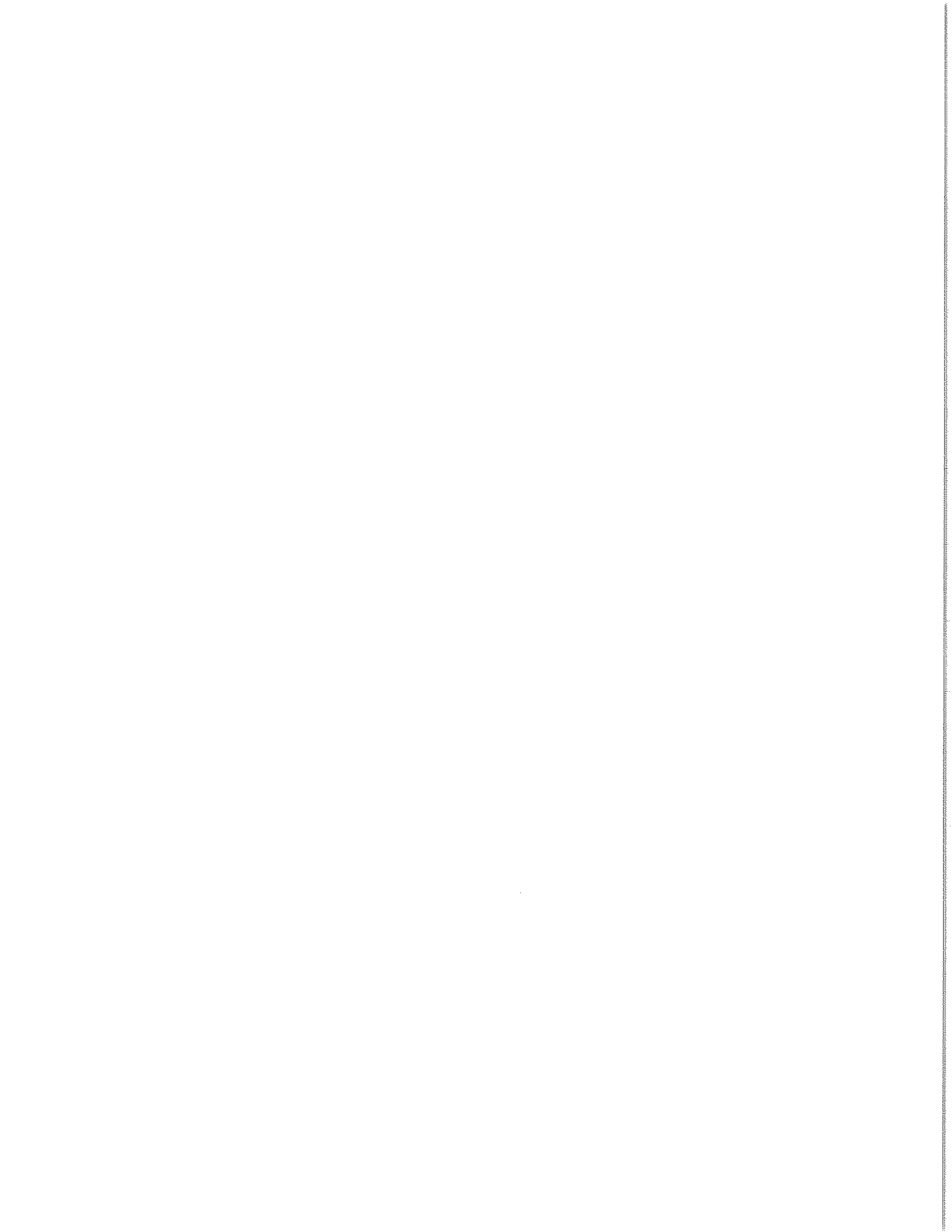
