

TOWN OF WHITESTOWN
LOCAL LAW # 1 OF THE YEAR 2022

Section 1: Title

This Local Law shall be referred to as the “Local Law Extending the Temporary Moratorium on and Prohibition of Large Scale Solar Installation within the Town of Whitestown”.

Section 2: Purpose and Intent

On October 20, 2021, the Town Board adopted Local Law #3 of 2021 entitled the “Temporary Moratorium on and Prohibition of Large Scale Solar Installations within the Town of Whitestown” which became effective on November 3, 2021, upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.

The Town Board for the Town of Whitestown has conducted a public hearing and solicited comments from the public, property owners, and solar installation developers, and reviewed similar regulations adopted or being considered for adoption by nearby towns concerning the proposed regulation of solar installations. However, additional time is needed to finalize the draft regulations being considered, and to provide sufficient time for the Town Board to formally adopt such regulations as a local law.

Section 3: Extension of Local Law #3 of 2021

Local Law #3 of 2021 the moratorium established by the local law entitled the “Temporary Moratorium on and Prohibition of Large Scale Solar Installations within the Town of Whitestown” is hereby extended until December 31, 2022. All terms, conditions, obligations, regulations, requirements, hardship variance procedures, and penalties contained therein shall continue without change during the extension.

Section 4: Effective Date

The effective date of the Local Law shall be upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
