**TOWN OF WHITESTOWN**  
**LOCAL LAW # 4 OF 2023**

**A LOCAL LAW INCREASING THE EXEMPTION ON TOWN  
TAXES BASED ON LIMITED INCOME FOR RESIDENTS OVER  
THE AGE OF 65**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WHITESTOWN, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I.    Purpose:**

The County of Oneida and the Whitesboro Central School District have each increased real estate tax exemptions to be granted to residents over the age of 65 with limited incomes. The Town desires to amend the tax exemptions available to senior citizens with limited incomes, so as to be consistent with the levels established by the County of Oneida and the Whitesboro Central School District.

**SECTION II.** Chapter 185 of the Code of the Town of Whitestown entitled "Taxation" at Section 185-2 entitled "Schedule of exemption" is hereby amended so as to change and/or replace the annual income levels and the percentage of the available real property tax exemption based thereon, and replace the same with the following scheduled reflecting the annual incomes and the percentage of the available real property tax that would be exempt based on such incomes:

<b>Annual Income</b>	<b>Percentage of Real Property Tax Exempt</b>
\$29,500.00 or less	50%
More than \$29,500 but less than \$30,500	45%
\$30,500 or more but less than \$31,500	40%
\$31,500 or more but less than \$32,500	35%
\$32,500 or more but less than \$33,400	30%
\$33,400 or more but less than \$34,300	25%
\$34,300 or more but less than \$35,200	20%
\$35,200 or more but less than \$36,100	15%
\$36,100 or more but less than \$37,000	10%
\$37,000 or more but less than \$37,900	5%

**SECTION III.**

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

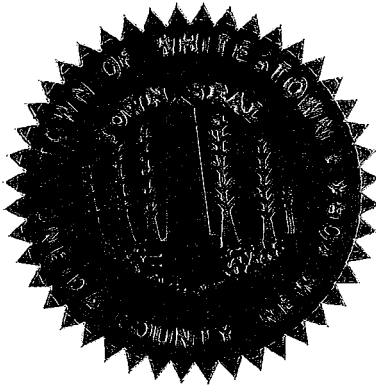
